Favor 2020 Summary Report

PBS's (Portable Bible Schools)¹

- 153 schools ran in South Sudan (SS) with 17,353 people graduating (each receiving a certificate and a Bible).
- Established the very first PBS on the Ethiopian border!!
- 31 locations ran in Uganda (UG) with 3,746 people graduating (each receiving a certificate and a Bible).
- PBS students facilitated 17,518 salvations during their 2-month leadership training!

TC (Trauma Counseling)

- 2,032 people who were in need of trauma counseling received help and graduated from the program in SS.
 - 923 people who were in need of trauma counseling received help and graduated from the program in UG.
- (Among these participants, 1,868 made a decision to follow Christ with their whole lives for the first time!)

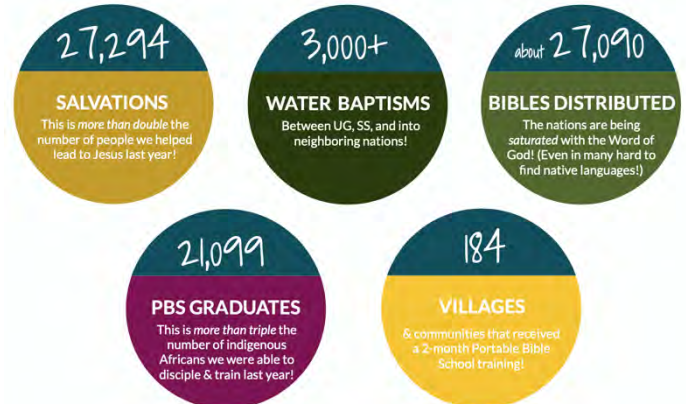
Bibles Distributed

- 17,948+ paper Bibles in over 12 languages, and 281 audio Bibles in SS.
- 9,142+ paper Bibles in over 12 languages, and 249 audio Bibles in UG.

LTI (Leadership Training Institute)

- 95 national leaders enrolled from UG, 52 from SS, and 32 people enrolled in our 2-year Bible College!

Radio

- In SS, there were over 200 calls per week, and about an average of 28 people called per month to receive Christ!
- Began to livestream via Facebook, reaching all of SS and the world.
- Renovated the Juba Radio Station studio.
- In UG, there was an average of 443 calls/week to receive prayer or share a testimony, and there was an average of 193 salvations/month through Radio!
- Calls and prayers increased dramatically in 2020 in UG (because the covid-19 restrictions on gathering caused more people to interact via the airwaves).



GIFT (God's Institute for Transformation)

- Over 200 youth, mostly from the streets of Gulu, UG are in Favor's full custody, becoming the future leaders of nations.
- 3,456 youth are enrolled in community programs and being disciplined in SS.



Church Construction

- 17 churches built this year (9 in UG, 8 in SS)
- With a total of 31 churches built since 2018, Favor has more than doubled our cumulative total in 2020!



Women Empowerment Projects

- 337 direct beneficiaries in SS.
- 1,070 direct beneficiaries in UG.
- Each woman helps provide for her family from each income-generating project.

Houses of Prayer (Evangelism Outreaches)

- 4,827+ people were converted from other faiths to become believers of Jesus Christ just from our House of Prayer evangelism outreaches!
- 2,713+ people gave testimonies that God healed or delivered them, due to prayer.

Business as Missions

- Farming began with rice planting and fish farming excavation (which will help feed the Destiny Youth at the GIFT Home and our school programs in UG).

Favor Staff

In 2019, we had 90 full-time staff members in SS alone. In 2020, because of the growth of all of our departments, our SS staff grew to a total of 216 indigenous staff members, field teachers, and volunteers. In UG this year, we had a total of 132 full-time staff members, an increase of 25 since 2019.

We employed 348 indigenous leaders in 2020.





Salvations and Baptisms

Across all of Favor's ministries in both countries, in 2020 we saw (that we know of):

- 27,294+ new brothers and sisters committed to following Jesus as their Lord and Savior!
- 3,054 new believers baptized.

Many of Favor's key statistics in 2020 doubled from the previous year!!

MULTIPLIED GROWTH

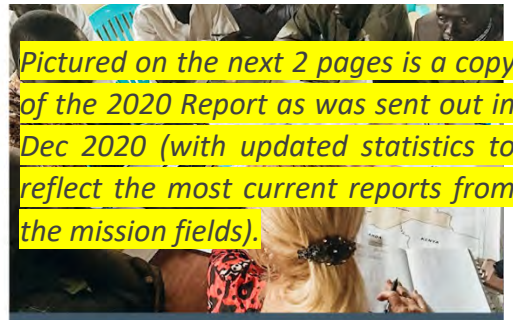
We saw multiplied growth in many areas of outreach this year! Especially in two main areas:

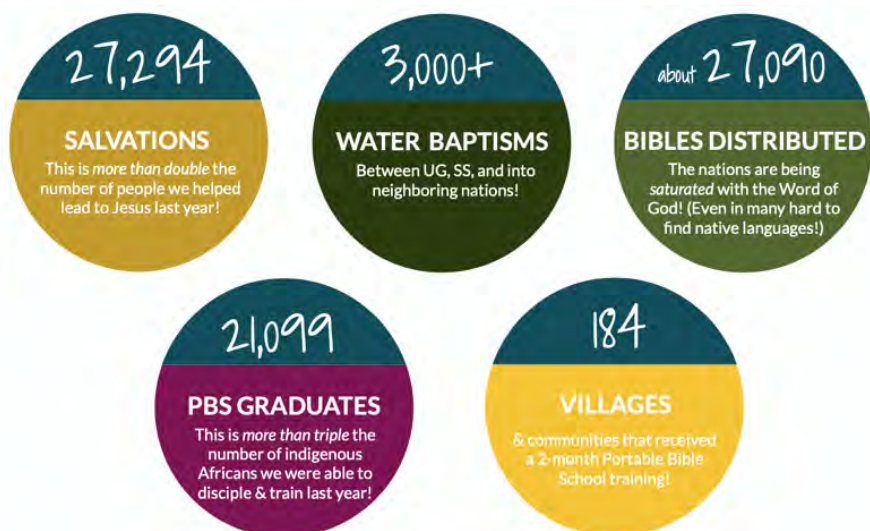

While we've communicated with you most about REEP & GIFT this year (because they are the current greatest needs), we want to be sure to also highlight that the many other nation-changing endeavors & outreaches that Favor is running with have continued to thrive as well! We built a total of 31 churches, reached over 1,200 women through our Women Empowerment project, successfully navigated a global pandemic with creative ways to still reach children through our Favor Primary School, trained leaders through our Leadership Training Institute, focused on economic empowerment & sustainability through our Business as Missions program, and much more!

On the US side of things, we were very pleased to have our Financial Statements audited and the results enthusiastically commended by our Board of Directors. We also added some fantastic additions to the US Team to help carry the load! And we launched a brand new website (please check it out...it will paint a much more thorough picture of the many facets and focuses that make up our overall vision to see *transformed hearts transforming nations*!)

- As our ministry and reach multiplies, our current most pressing need is to pay off a unique campus (a 5-acre plot in Gulu for GIFT expansion), with a remaining balance of \$250,000 left!

Ministry Reports

Rural Evangelism and Empowerment Program (REEP)

REEP is Favor's keystone community development ministry that sees whole communities at a time revived into Kingdom life.



The foundation of community development through REEP is Favor's Portable Bible Schools (PBS's). Our PBS's mobilize new disciple-makers in spiritual and physical war zones. Hungry for the Word and training, these emerging leaders come from hidden corners for this two-month theological education which Favor brings to rural villages...constantly moving further and further into unreached tribes and people groups. This ministry helps tens of

thousands overcome many barriers by the Holy Spirit and with the Word of God.

Our team of dedicated field teachers spend two months in the field preaching, teaching and enrolling as many students as possible. The training curriculum empowers students to realize their full calling and become weapons of the Gospel for winning souls to Christ. Each PBS trains participants to live Biblically in Jesus's Kingdom and multiply disciples.

This education, offered for free to all who commit to put the whole Word of God into practice, covers the essential theological training anyone would need to serve as a pastor, teacher, or in any other function of the body of Christ.

Most importantly, each of the tens of thousands of African leaders that graduate the PBSs leaves with the Holy Spirit, the means to continually learn from God throughout their walk, a physical Bible in their own language, and the training to make disciples and start or rejuvenate healthy congregations of people following Jesus together.

In 2020, Favor more than doubled the number of Portable Bible Schools (PBS's) training indigenous leaders who multiply their training to new generations of leaders in the furthest reaches of Africa.



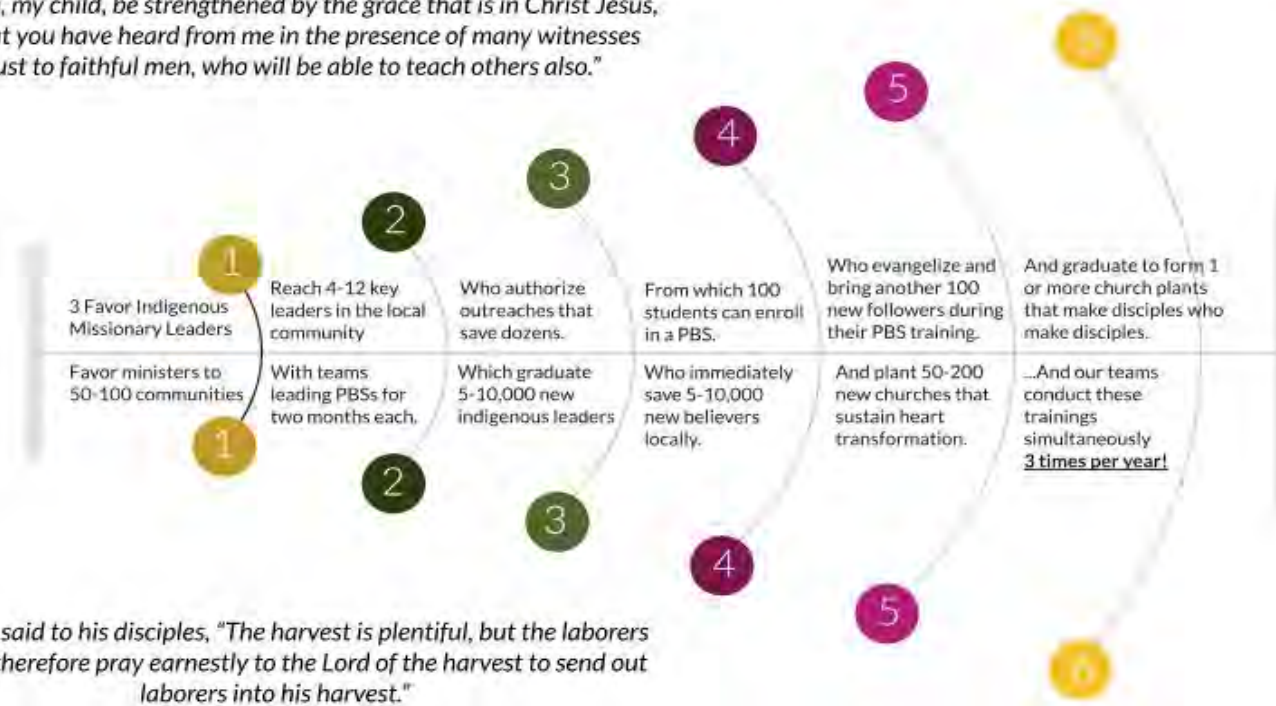


The impact of each PBS goes beyond the number of leaders that graduated (who make disciples who make disciples in places western missionaries will never reach), and the average number of salvations *during* each training. Because the lives of whole communities at a time are transformed by the Word of God. We regularly see warring tribes forgive one another, physical healing, empowerment of women, children raised in stable families, and education being brought through revitalized churches and new church plants. It is truly remarkable to behold.

2020 REEP Highlights, South Sudan (SS)

The mission of Favor's REEP team in SS is to train and equip the indigenous people from all 64 tribes of South Sudan to rise up in their calling to take the Gospel of Christ to unreached people groups regionally and even into the surrounding nations.

In 2020, the field teams ran PBS's, Trauma Counseling, and more, impacting communities and transforming the hearts of people through the power of the Gospel holistically applied. Favor's teams worked aggressively to save many people.

- Mobilized three waves of PBS's in 153 locations.
- Trained 17,353 new indigenous leaders who facilitated 17,244 new salvations during their training (including the 2,032 Trauma Counseling graduates).

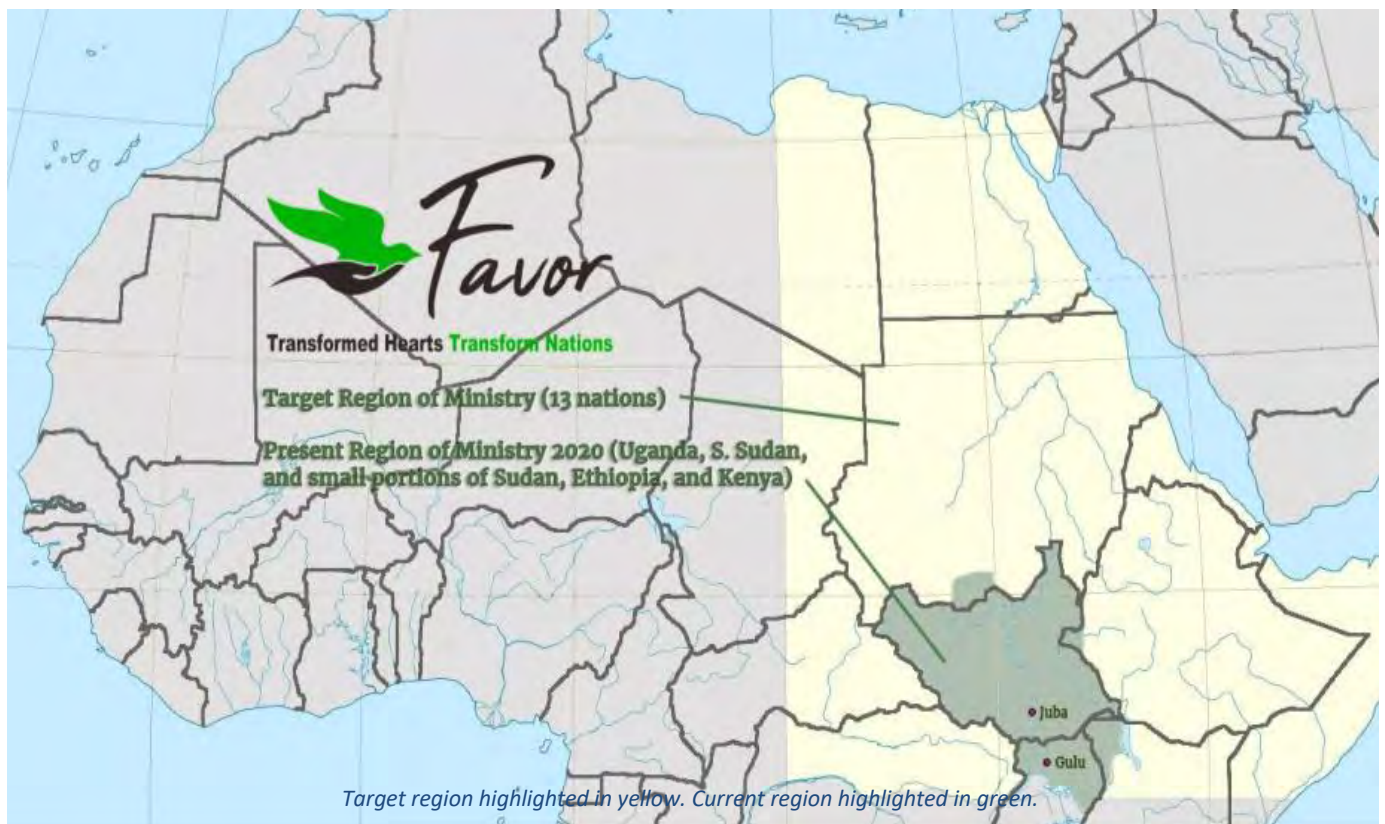


- Baptized 2,891 new believers.

Favor's PBS's are requested from surrounding nations!

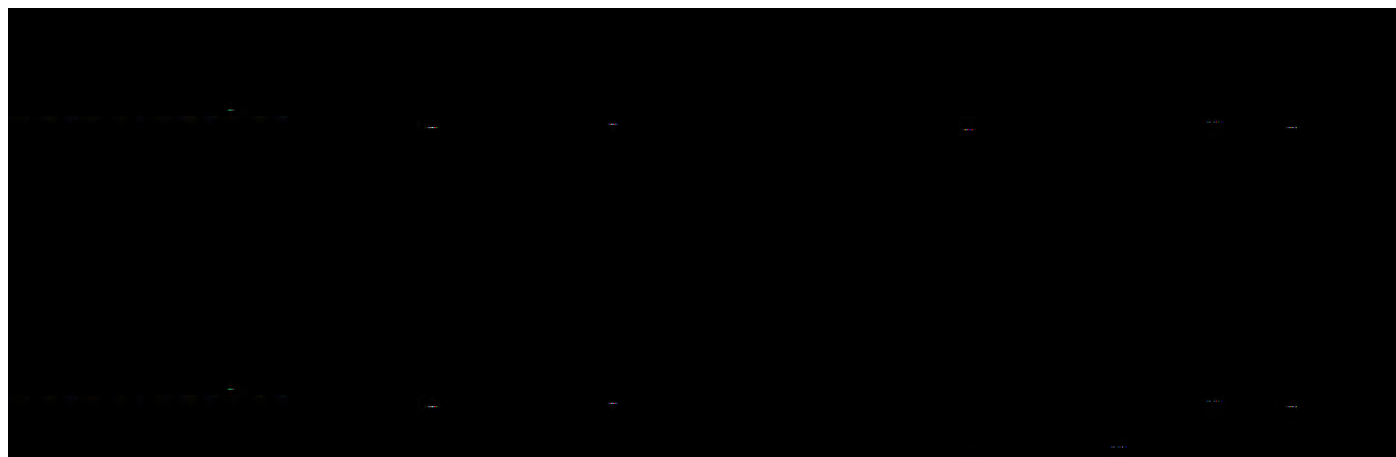
- Planted new churches with PBS's amongst Muslim-dominated areas.

Due to a history steeped in war, many communities in Uganda and South Sudan possess deep, unresolved emotional wounds. 66,000 children in northern Uganda alone were abducted and forced to become combatants and sex slaves. Many have had relatives murdered or maimed right before their eyes. Many have been forced to kill or be killed. To meet this need, Favor's Trauma Counseling focuses on people who have experienced traumatic life events. Every person who participates has their own story of tragedy.

"Please bring your trauma counseling. We're all traumatized in South Sudan... I'm traumatized."

The 2-week Trauma Counseling experience focuses on forgiveness: God's forgiveness toward us, and our own forgiveness toward those who hurt us. In addition, stories and sharing time helps the participants understand their pain and trauma from another perspective, while giving them the opportunity to discuss the events they've experienced. Trauma Counseling is an important step for them to find healing, gain strength, and develop skills to become successful in life.

The mission of Favor's REEP team in UG is to train and equip the pastors, evangelists, and all other Christian ministers who have a call to serve the Lord Jesus, and to build God's kingdom in their respective Church congregations and communities.

The two-month period of training by our dedicated field teachers involves enrolling students, teaching, praying, door to door evangelism, and water baptisms. After the two months of training the students graduate with certificates and receive.

Adult Literacy, Uganda

In some of the rural areas where our teams work, there are many people who cannot read or write. There are several reasons for this; one of which is that many people dropped out of school during the 20+ years of insurgency and genocide that took place in northern Uganda at the time Favor was established there.

It's well established that literacy is essential to the wellness of communities in many ways, and we've found that the best way to teach literacy is *with the Bible!* Bible-based literacy classes have been one of the most helpful classes in our communities.

Trauma Counseling, Uganda

As in South Sudan, there are many in Uganda who have a deep need for Trauma Counseling as well. There are refugee settlements where we work that is populated by South Sudanese refugees who fled from the decades of war and instability in their nation, seeking security and a way to live. There are also many Ugandans who have lived through and experienced devastating and unthinkable atrocities at the hands of one of the most brutal rebel war leaders in history. As such, our Trauma Counseling team in UG works to bring healing and whole restoration to groups that have been particularly afflicted by tragedy and hopelessness.

One testimony is of a woman named Elisabeth. She testified after a Trauma Counseling session that beforehand, her life was controlled by bad thoughts that resulted from her



past experience in war, the relatives she lost in the war, shortages of food, and more. After participating in Trauma Counseling, she said that she is now able to deal with those thoughts and is able to give everything to God who is the giver of every good thing. As a South Sudanese refugee, she reported that she is now optimistic that one day she will be able to return to her homeland.

One man named Jacob said that the things he experienced made turned him into a violent and angry man. The Trauma Counseling that he received helped give him the emotional strength to overcome that anger.

God's Institute for Transformation (GIFT), Uganda

War and its rippling effects have left thousands orphaned throughout UG and SS. Many desperate youths are the sole providers for siblings, live on the streets, and are neglected in prisons for crimes of survival. In these situations, education is impossible, simple injuries are crippling, and meals are hard to find. Childhood dreams are lost as life's one goal becomes survival.



The GIFT is a home and family for youth who need Jesus with skin on. GIFT is not just a program. Rather, it is a 24/7 family.

It is not just an orphanage (which the UG government discourages in favor of a foster care system with extended family members in the villages). GIFT is a holistic solution to a total need: mentoring, physical needs, education, vocational skills and opportunities, salvation and discipleship, and starting a new life with Jesus in a real family. The Gulu Institute for Transformation in UG provides the following, 24/7:



- Discipleship & Bible teaching
- Mentoring
- Counseling & Rehab
- Education & study materials
- Bibles
- Food, Shelter, and Clothing
- Real family units
- Vocational skills
- Life skills
- Career opportunities within and beyond the ministry



In 2020, the GIFT department was upgraded to support the youths who are on the streets of Gulu City and the neighboring regions, as we saw a massive influx of youths. We also have 55 Ladies of Destiny (former sex workers/prostitutes) who have been screened from Layibi division Gulu city for future support.

As of December 2020, GIFT in UG has 133 youths under our full-time care (46 girls / 87 boys), plus 55 additional girls once housing is ready. Currently, each of these young people are learning Arabic (so that they can become missionaries to the surrounding Muslim nations!), and a skill or trade that they can use to provide for themselves and their future families (like construction, mechanic, fishery, tailoring, or hair dressing), and those who are of school age receive upper and lower primary education, with the normal classroom lessons.

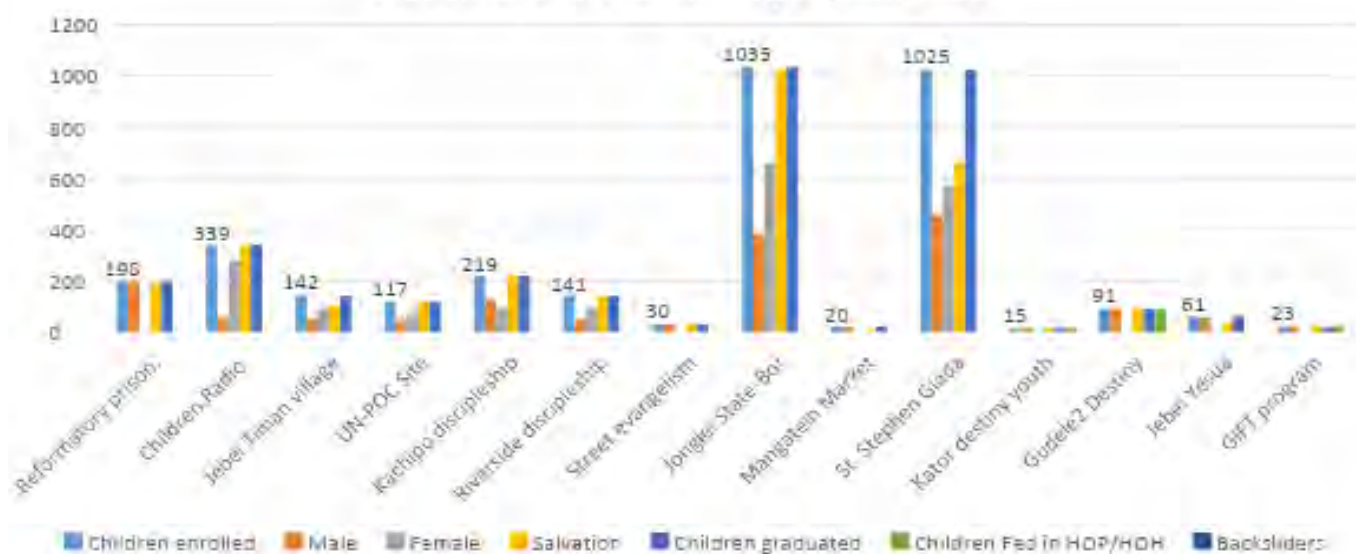

Each HOP consists of Favor-employed staff members and community volunteers who are work whole-heartedly to help raise indigenous leaders who will carry out the Great Commission of our Lord Jesus in the government, media, education, business, arts, family, and every other sphere of influence.

Lunch Hour services is one of the activities that has been running at the HOP since 2005. This service gathers community members who are hungry to have an experience with God through prayer, worship, and the Word every Monday through Friday. An average of 200 people attend this lunch-time service *daily*.



These services impact so many lives from the community: people receive jobs, promotions, raises, marriages are strengthened, and many begin to walk in righteousness and follow Christ wholeheartedly. Many prayer lives are strengthened and several newborn babies were dedicated before the Lord in this altar!

In addition to the Lunch Hour weekday service, Door-to-Door Evangelism is one of the major outreaches conducted by the HOP Team. In 2020, the team conducted 45 door-to-door outreaches. During these outreaches, a total of 380 people gave their lives to Christ!

Fasting and prayer is a foundational part of who we are as a ministry...both collectively and individually.



All of our staff in each nation regularly fasts and prays throughout the year. We did even more so in 2020 during covid-19 lockdowns and for tumultuous elections in both nations.

2020 began with our HOP team hosting 3 great crusades in Aweil, Wau, and Rumbek, South Sudan.

The mobilization and coordination led to a turnout of a massive crowd of over 700,000 people.

Several thousand people responded to the salvation call, with hundreds of healing and deliverance testimonies. When we say that we see the book of Acts in action, this is just one example of when.

Church Building Construction

New church buildings are significant in the regions where we work because they testify to the communities that God is here to stay! In the rural communities that make up roughly 80% of the nation's population, small congregations usually meet in huts or underneath large mango trees. The many areas in northern UG (where war was strongest a decade ago) and in SS (where it is still ongoing), many times, a Christian presence is absent altogether.

Bibles tend to be scarce in many of these communities, and poor teaching of the Word causes believers to mix their faith with local superstition and the occult. We hope to see the roots of establishing the body of Christ that we have carefully nurtured further solidified with a physical church building.

Practically, the church becomes a central gathering place for the communities and is one of the most effective means of reaching and transforming lives. This is where continued life skills classes are held, youth sports and activities operate, and so much more. This further establishes a place for the young children to anchor to. Just one church planted in an unreached community can affect *countless* generations.





Church Construction, South Sudan (SS)

In SS in 2020, we constructed eight new church buildings! Many of these communities experience revival, as they receive many new followers of Jesus and utilize the new facilities for worship, prayer, and community gatherings. These buildings routinely boost the rate of new people converting to the faith, as they tangibly see that Jesus is here to stay.

Women Empowerment (WE)

Women in the regions we serve face many unique challenges. And surprisingly, it is their income that most directly sustains the family unites. Tragic losses (which are easily preventable by education and medical care) oftentimes compound their struggle to break free from poverty.

Our WE ministry helps to end these cycles by equipping women to generate their own income through training in skills, emotional wholeness, parenting, and financial management. This income gains them a measure of respect and independence while funding the medical and educational needs of all their children.

Favor leadership teams select women who have demonstrated faithfulness through regular tithing and attendance at church and Community Revitalization sessions. Every WE meeting starts with individual and community goal setting. Through conversation, the team helps the women discover solutions uniquely suited to their circumstances. Based on interest, skills and resources the women may choose from a variety of vocational projects: artisan training in beads and textiles, cows and plows farming, animal husbandry involving poultry, pigs or goats, tailoring, or bread making. Once decided, our team helps the women form their own structure and accountability system. The women leave these meetings with a solution in hand and joyful in the newfound knowledge of their God-given gifts.

Radio

Favor operates two radio stations: one in Gulu, UG and another in Juba, SS. These stations reach communities and individuals who would otherwise not have access to even hear God's Word. We call these teams the "air force" for Gospel-powered transformation! In 2020, we saw the significance of this form of outreach grow significantly in UG as in-person gatherings were restricted due to covid-19.



Governments and communities have acknowledged the immense value of our Radio programs in shaping perspectives and informed decision-making processes, as well as accelerating learning. Foremost is the Gospel, then we also use it for training on health education, businesses, family and social values, post-war recovery, and much more. Our programming is a mix of teaching, music, news, testimonies, prayer, preaching, education, and more. Favor stays on the cutting edge of programming, production, and marketing, in order to strive for financial sustainability.

Significant Activities in 2020:

- We had a complete overhaul of the radio studio in the month of May, giving it a beautiful vibrant look.



- We were able to run the radio 24-hours a day, giving our listeners access to the prerecorded word of God all through the night.
- We began streaming radio content live through Facebook. With this, we are able to reach over a thousand listeners both in South Sudan and across the globe, especially during our Bible studies programs which we conduct three nights a week.
- With increase in the preaching of the word of God we were able to receive over 700 salvations and healing testimonies.
- We set up a power backup system to run the radio in a crisis situation.



Just a Few Testimonies:

- A woman named Suzan in Juba testified that she had not been able to conceive, but after being prayed for on the radio in August 2019, she gave birth in June 2020!
- A man named Emmanuel testified that he had a wound in his ear. After being prayed for by our presenter Isaac, he received healing from God instantly!



- Suzan testified of being healed after being prayed for on the radio. She said that he had had a swollen leg!

Radio Ministry and House of Prayer Join Forces to Minister During Uganda Shutdowns

The Radio Department has greatly helped the HOP team reach out to the masses both before and during the lockdown on church service imposed from March through October this year. We conducted a number of lunch hour services on radio, where we reached out to several thousand each week, and with special programs like breakthrough overnight prayers live on air. New online services streamed live on Facebook and Youtube. The viewership has been between 100-1,500 people per livestream!

2020 has been a turnaround year for Favour FM due to the diligence and consistency in performance. Favour FM has joined the top three most popular radio stations in northern Uganda! Currently our listenership is estimated to reach 3 million people. This achievement comes by the grace of God! This year we have 10 committed team members handling different activities.



In 2020, Favour FM increased daily preaching of the Word from three times daily to ten times daily. Preaching and teaching the Word of God is our core value, strength, and primary responsibility!

We also organized more on-air prayer time to increase hope and faith during the worst moments of the government shutdowns. This prayer time was so powerful that many Christians experienced the hand of God in their lives: families and health were restored, broken hearts fixed, and people reported their hope was restored again.

Overnight praise and prayer by the “Vocal Shepherds” launched every Friday in 2020 for three months in the year. This series generated the largest listenership for Favour FM, and many people testified to what God was doing during the prayer time. People have requested for the frequency of this program to increase. 300 People got saved in this program alone, from May to July 2020. 800 testimonies were recorded.

Daily testimonies at Favour FM during 2020 included:

- Healings of diseases, cancers, malaria, etc.
- Healings of physical conditions, blindness, deafness, paralysis, etc.

- Provision of material miracles, new jobs, debtors repaying, etc.



Leadership Training Institute (LTI) and Bible Distribution

Our LTI is a blend of in-class and hands-on instruction tailored to produce powerful ministers of spiritual and cultural transformation engaged in the work of renewal before they ever leave the classroom.

Comprised of six separate schools, the LTI builds up every facet of the student's character and vocation over two years, from ministerial preparation to business skills.



This university-level 4-year degree program caps effective preparation for empowered leadership. The training fills academic gaps that are common from prior educational institutions while adding training not found elsewhere in northern Uganda or South Sudan. The coursework is intended to be completed by working ministers and professional leaders in 3-5 years.

Favor Bible Distribution

The LTI departments handle all the Bible distribution logistics for all the other departments and ministries of Favor.

Favor distributes tens of thousands of Bibles in printed and audio format in dozens of languages—through relationship—in every ministry we conduct. All PBS graduates receive a Bible. The youth



programs are diligently centered on a lifestyle of Bible study. We teach adult literacy in the villages, which gives us the opportunity to use the Bible as a primary resource for reading practice. Even through the two Radio Stations, we allow those who call in with a testimony of how the radio has impacted them to pick up a free bible.



With the majority of the population that we minister to, the Word is the essential core of our foundation. People across South Sudan and Uganda (and beyond) know that Favor is known for the Word of God in action...and for Bibles. If one person can't read, they find someone in the village who can and they have them read aloud every evening around the campfire, while the village families gather and listen. It's a beautiful sight to see as God uses all avenues in Favor to deliver the hope in his Word to all his people in Uganda and South Sudan.

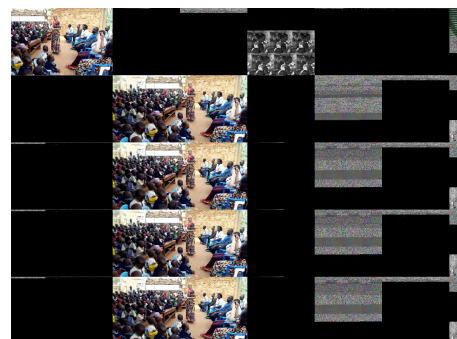
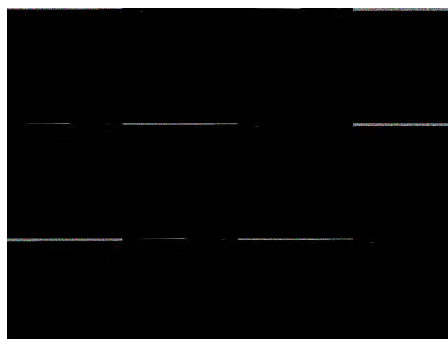
