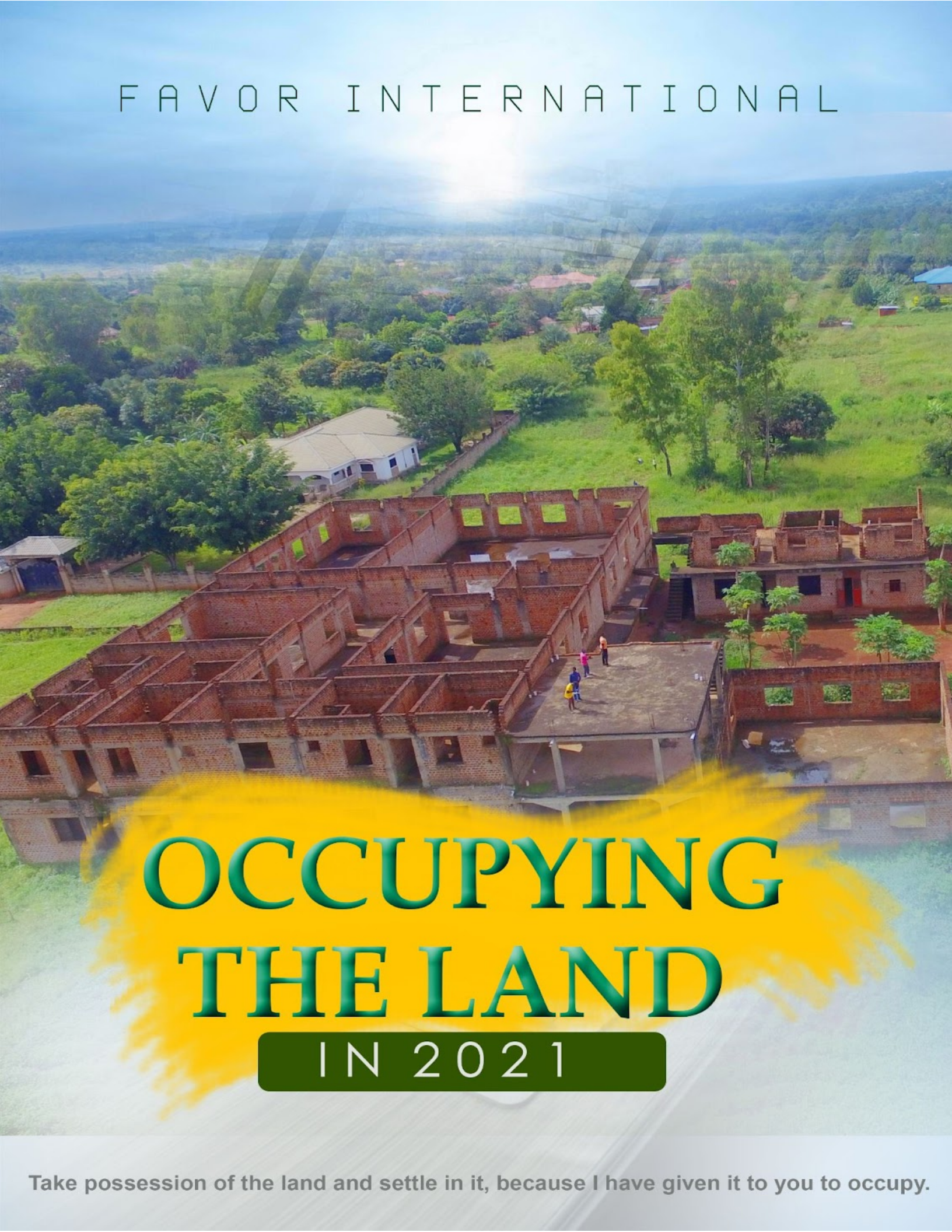

✂RURAL EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM - REEP

Rural Education and Evangelism Program (REEP) is aimed at accomplishing the Great commission in Matt. 28:18-20, *'Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit'*. This is what we are called for. We train rural and urban pastors, church leaders and believers the true doctrine of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Many pastors and church leaders, especially in rural areas, have not had any formal bible training which makes them prone to wrong doctrines and false teaching. This program aimed at training local leaders and nurturing new believers to grow in the Word of God and the Word of God in them!

Besides conducting bible training, our field teachers also see deliverance, door to door evangelism, discipleship, salvation and water baptism – at the end of the training, learners are given bibles, certificates and other discipleship materials. An average of 100+ attend the portable bible schools and another 100 people become born again through door to door evangelism.

✠GOD'S INSTITUTE FOR TRANSFORMATION - GIFT

After two decades of war in northern Uganda, we witnessed a significant increase in numbers of street children in most cities and towns of northern Uganda and Gulu city became the hub. There has been high increase in the level of social evils like burglary, theft, drug abuse, prostitution, murder and general insecurity in its entirety. Juba in South Sudan is also known for great insecurities and violence leading to many children fend for themselves on the streets of the city.

In 2019, God directed our effort to start GIFT project (God's institute for transformation) aimed at helping these street connected children to be fully transformed and re-integrated back to their respective communities through educational and vocational training like hairdressing, tailoring, brick laying, mechanic and vehicle repairs among others.

We have 188 youths under our care (120 girls) and (68 boys) within the three centers in Gulu city and 23 boys in Juba, South Sudan.

↔WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

The Women Empowerment Project (WEP) is an ongoing initiative birthed to partner with churches constructed by ICM funding through Favor of God Ministries. WEP made tremendous achievements towards its goal; Restoring lives value and dignity in the rural communities of Northern Uganda through the women. The project conducted a variety of life changing teachings, baseline survey, follow up, economic empowerment through providing income generating activities, project phase out, media campaigns, marriage conferences and capacity building amongst others.

The year 2021 was registered as successful with many achievements amidst challenges brought mainly by the outbreak of the **PANDEMIC, COVID 19**. The project expanded its scope of operation to reach a record number of 1970 people directly with its activities and more than 3950 people directly from the villages.

The year is viewed as successful as most of the preset objective were accomplished like; Restoration of lives by ending abortion and infanticide against baby girls and boys, restoration of dignity by ending sex trafficking, multiple parents, domestic violence and abuse against women or men, replacing them with loving marriage and Godly families that reflects the full glory of God, increased economic activity in under-resourced communities and having more people(women) engaged in innovative solutions to improve livelihood. Other new sites for the project will be opened on fund acquisition in the subsequent year.

SOME TESTIMONIES

Bringing about life change in single mothers: Changing the economic hemisphere in the rural areas positively is one of the key goals of the women empowerment project. With the follow up on the progress of the project and its impact on the local community of Lagude village, the project found Josephine Angom who is one of our beneficiaries now owning a small scale retail outlet (grocery store) in the village. She was happy to say boldly that the project has really touched her life through its teachings and piggery project handed to her family.



She added that being a single mother, she concentrated on the piggery project using the piggery management skill and was able to support her 5 children in school. She said that she used the project to acquire a goat and open the shop. Her daughter who is currently out of school due to the lock down is effectively and diligently running the business with the business skills transferred to her through the women empowerment project. *This has*

become the second shop in the trading center that is at the verge of growing. The project is proud to mention that the center has only two retail shops that are both birthed through the women empowerment project. Attached is Josephine and her daughter Irene standing in their shop.

Economic empowerment of communities: The women of Oyenya village have for the past two years been undergoing teachings and training on various life changing lessons. They have in addition to the teachings been blessed with piglets as a way of changing their economic way of living for the better. They received the first 100 pigs altogether through the women empowerment project. This stands out to be the 13th project that has been supported.

The women's group together with the local leaders, embraced the project and thanked the ministry for remembering the women in the village of Oyenya in their programs. The women pledged to maintain the project with diligence and has emerged as the best project in the area. To the right are the women receiving their piglets.





Elevating and Empowering lives: Margret was also one of the members who was reached through the activities of the project. The project transformed the life of Margret and her entire family by providing an opportunity to operate a retail business paving the way for store construction and stocking the shop. This has provided a new source of livelihood to this family and

restored hope which had been lost for years.

Margret testified that she is a woman whose husband has four other wives and because of receiving Christ, her husband abandoned her for other women. She further continued that the project has elevated her to the extent that even without her husband, her family is doing better than the other concubines' families. She extended her gratitude for the wonderful work done by God in her family through the women empowerment project



❖LEADERSHIP TRAINING INSTITUTE

As a department we are grateful to God for taking us through this year and in spite of the pandemic, we were able to serve God. We accomplished a number of activities such as Staff Leadership development training program, Staff discipleship program, One on one counselling, Discipleship program at the GIFT homes, conducted water baptism, Teaching on marriage and families, Favor International school of ministry started, Bible distribution, Children's discipleship program,

↔**BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT/BAM**

This department is involved in taking our projects and ventures and helping them become part of the self-sustainability of the ministry. We identify the opportunities and turn them into viable businesses, then grow them to become income-generating. The business development part of the ministry just started in 2021 when we realized that some of the projects we were doing could grow enough to help sustain the ministry in the future.

1. BAM DEPARTMENT

HERE we have the fishery, crop production, and animal production. This department has three staff working in the department and five volunteers working on the projects .

- In fishery, we have 17,000 fish in our nine fish ponds, and out of these one 114 fish has been sold at the worth of \$155 USD. 2022 will see greater sales as our fish grow to a marketable size.
- In animal production, we have 18 goats that are being kept and managed by the bam team who are trained in agriculture and animal husbandry.
- In crop production, we have just started vegetable production, however now we have seven and a half acres of maize on farmland and two and a half acres of cassava in the gardens. Our 280 acres farm will take up full production and harvesting in 2022.

Next year our plans for BAM are to do 100 acres of maize and 50 acres of soya beans in the first season and 100 acres of rice, 50 acres for maize, 10 acres of bananas and mixed with peanuts in the second season.

2. Urban business

We also just started urban business this year that are located in the city of Gulu

- We have the Favor of God events and bridal shop. It is new in the market but we have consistent income through hiring of GOWNS, tents and chairs rentals. We have four 100-seater tents and one 50-seater tent and 100 chairs with 30 Gowns in the shops but we plan to have more items as we make money.

- We have favor bakery! This has one staff and it has a capacity of producing bread that can supply all of Favor ministry plus selling some to the public. In Favor Bakery we have two metallic ovens and one bread slicer. Our plan is to expand as we increase our production and open up an outlet to the community where they come and buy from.
- The third business is concrete block projects where we are making blocks, poles, and many more concrete materials.

Once all these businesses are opened, we will be able to generate income and provide employment to the Youth.

3. Radio department

This section has about 13 staff working here with an average monthly income of 20,000,000 and a monthly expense of 28,000,000 however we plan to open up a branch in Kampala to help with national business so I believe we will make break-even next year



4. School department

We have a primary school section where our enrollment is moderate and at present, we are teaching the density youth in both primary and secondary sections however we plan to enroll from the community this

will raise some income to support the ministry projects, the section has 20 working teachers in primary, secondary

✂CHURCH CONSTRUCTION

The year 2021 ended with most exciting successful accomplishment in all our departmental projects crosscutting from ICM (International Corporation Ministries) – Church construction, discipleship and church planting

ICM department - Provides incorporated activities support on physical and spiritual growth, this output is achieved through three major activities or projects such as; the construction of Churches, Foundational teachings (Discipleship programs) formerly known as “Mini Bible College”, and empowering women by training them on the basic skills and livelihood skills

✂PRIMARY SCHOOL

The mission of Favour Primary School is to educate the next generation of Uganda's leadership with the Word of God, prayer, and academic excellence. Our school of 350-400 elementary grade level students includes children from all walks of life, backgrounds, and income levels. We openly teach and practice the Word of God, and these amazing children regularly come to know the love of Jesus as they pray and see God move.



The school was seriously interrupted by the Covid19 pandemic. Due to that, school pupils were locked out of school for nearly two years. A staggered program was introduced where some groups of learners could report to school for a term then other groups would follow. Considering the shift study program, the government only opened schools for Grades 4-7 while the rest of the students didn't have an opportunity to study at all from March 2020 to January 2022.

❖CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Our Construction department carries out construction work, building churches, digging wells, repairs and maintenance in the various locations/properties/compounds owned by the ministry.

With development at a rapid pace there are numerous ongoing projects at any given time.

2021 saw us construct and finish a fisheries building, start on our primary school, do renovations on the GIFT girls home and much more in Uganda plus we began to develop our new lands in Juba.



✂MEDICAL DEPARTMENT

The Medical facility in both countries currently offers its services internally to Staffs and their Dependents, over 200 GIFT Children and Critical Cases within the Community who need medical assistance. Currently the Total Number of Staff benefitting from the clinic is over 200 plus spouses and dependents.

The Clinics also operates on Mobile status where Clinic days are organized for the GIFT youth at their residence and also staff home treatment when unable to ambulate to the clinic. Our clinic also conducts mobile medical clinic and health care training in remote and hard to reach villages.

Our facility in Gulu is getting ready to open as a fully operational clinic to the public in February of 2022. Healing hands and Caring Hearts is our motto and we never treat the body without prayer.
